Included below are details and information related to the 2024 North Dakota Shrine Bowl, which is to be played at 4:00 pm (9-man) and 7:00 pm (11-man) on Saturday, June 22nd at Jerome Berg Field on the campus of Mayville State University.

REGISTRATION - Tuesday, June 18th, 12:00 Noon – 1:00 pm, Agassiz Hall, Mayville State University

MEALS & HOUSING - All meals will be provided (lunch will not be served on the day of check-in) and all four teams will be housed in Agassiz Hall.

GAME UNIFORM - You are asked to bring \$50 when you report. This is to partially cover the cost of your game jersey. The jersey will be yours to keep after the game. You will be asked to turn in your game pants following the game.

EQUIPMENT –Your high school must provide you with all football protective equipment, including NOCSAE approved helmet, practice jersey, practice pants, girdle pads, knee pads, shorts, belt, mouthpiece, and football shoes. You will practice on grass/field turf and the game will be played on Field Turf.
